



clubgolf Level 1 Development Course

This course is for existing Level 1 coaches wishing to refresh and upgrade their coaching skills.

The course begins by placing an emphasis on the experiences, and shared experiences, of the coaches. This will provide the opportunity for the coaches to discuss the problems that they have incurred and also share good practice that might be adopted by the other coaches. This session will be facilitated by the Coach Education Tutors who will offer advice with regards to the problems that have been raised by the Level 1 coaches.

The main emphasis of the course will be to develop the key 'how-to' skills learnt on the Level 1 course. The 'how-to' coach skills are as follows:

- * Creating a fun session
- * Instruction & Explanation
- * Analysis & Comparison
- * Safety
- * Demonstration
- * Organisation
- * Observation
- * Feedback

The course will be concluded with a group discussion to ascertain the ongoing needs of the existing Level 1 coaches.

*** Please Note: Only PGA licensed coaches are eligible to attend a clubgolf Level 1 Development course.**
